

**NOTICE OF REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
OF THE FRY FIRE DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD**

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the citizens of the Fry Fire District and the general public that the Fry Fire Board will hold its monthly meeting at 7:00 p.m., Wednesday March 19, 2014 at the Fry Fire District Station #2 located at 4817 S. Apache Avenue, Sierra Vista, Arizona.

5. Conflict of Interest: Board Members shall declare any conflict of interest as required by law in A.R.S.§38-501 through A.R.S.§38-504 with the following statement: “I (name) declare that I have conflict of interest on item (number) before the board and I will refrain from discussing and voting on matters in which I have a conflict”

6. Call to the Public: A.R.S. § 38-431.01. Speakers are limited to a **three-minute oral presentation** and may submit written comments of any length for Governing Board files. Board Members may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the Governing Board, and may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be placed on a future agenda. However, the Governing Board will not discuss or take action on a matter raised during a call to the Public and is not obligated to comment upon materials or presentations made by the public.

7. **Fire Chief’s Report** – This is a summary of the activities of the Fire Chief and administrative staff concerning each of the District’s Operations including: Fire Suppression, Emergency Medical Services, Administrative Services, Finance, Human Resources, Special Projects, Logistics, Life Safety Services and Wild Land Fire Fighting; the report might also include Administrative Activities in Annexations, Intergovernmental Relations, Community Assistance Programs, Fleet and Equipment, Labor and Management Relations, Strategic Planning, Information Technology, Status of Construction Projects, Status of Facilities, Public Outreach and Training. The Governing Board may not propose, deliberate or take legal action during the report. Therefore, action taken as a result of the Chief’s report will be limited to directing staff to study the matter or scheduling the matter for further consideration and decision at a later date. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02 (K).

8. **Financial Report**-This report is a summary of the District’s Financial Status including: Monthly Board Financial Report, Monthly Disbursement Report, Maintenance & Operational Account Balance, Capital Reserve Balance, Leave Reserve Balance, Volunteer Pension Balance, Revenue and Expenditure Reports.
 - a. Review, discussion and possible action on the monthly financial report.
 - b. Review and discussion to accept the warrants issued for the month of February 2014.

Current fire code is the 2006 International Fire Code.
