Apache Avenue, Sierra Vista, Arizona.

Board Members may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the Governing Board, and may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be placed on a future agenda. However, the Governing Board will not discuss or take action on a matter raised during a call to the Public and is not obligated to comment upon materials or presentations made by the public.

8.
